

**ADDENDUM
TO
CONSTITUTION & BY-LAWS
THE WESTERN CAUCUS**

- #1. Each Department of The Western Caucus should strive to develop the qualities of leadership needed to provide The Western Caucus with a cadre of outstanding candidates for National Office up to and including National Commander.
- #2. Individuals who have demonstrated their commitment to the founding principals of The American Legion, whose selfless leadership abilities are readily apparent should be provided with every opportunity to further their skills in public speaking, social graces and appearance.
- #3. They should possess strong people skills that enable them to motivate and encourage volunteers, instilling within them the desire to succeed.
- #4. They should have attained a personal and knowledgeable background of all major programs of The American Legion.
- #5. Potential leaders should be encouraged to visit other departments to become better known on a regional basis.
- #6. A system of waivers or passes should be in place that would allow a department that is next in line in the rotation schedule, without a strong candidate, to step aside and allow another qualified individual from another department to be proposed.
